Captain Andrew's Column

Why are we waiting? Are we there yet? Have you ever heard that coming from the back seat of the car when going somewhere? Advent really means waiting, preparation and expectations. New attractions at Theme Parks use this sense of expectation by shrouding the new attraction, also new shops will 'whitewash' the windows so you can't see in. This heightens the tension and anticipation; 'What's going on here?' people say. That's something of what Advent is. The whole story leading up to the birth of Jesus is the same. Today we are reading one of the Birth Narrative's from Luke, but we are also looking at Psalm 46, with its familiar words 'Be Still and know I am God'. The trouble is we don't always do that do we. Take time to be still and wait especially now in this busy time pre-Christmas, perhaps it is more important to Be Still and consider the true meaning of the whole Christmas story; how God in His infinite wisdom sent His Son to Earth, and made his dwelling among us; John 1
