‘What on earth is going on?’ Have you ever said that? I’m sure we have many times. Think about the world situation now, and over past years, this is a question that comes up time after time. We ask how is God going to deal with it all. We are reflecting on Elijah today; he faced many challenging situations in his life and I’m sure he must have had similar questions for God. Elijah was a powerful prophet but he was just a man, when we read about him we learn he had formidable trust and belief in what God can do. We see something of this power that Elijah trusted in in today’s accounts from 1 Kings. Elijah faced a society where people had drifted from God and were worshipping other gods who they thought could provide what they wanted.
