Captain Andrews Column

What choices have you made today? We make them all the time; whether to get up! What to wear, eat, which way do we go. Sometimes we don’t have a choice, but in the majority of times we do have a choice. Some people say we have too many and it’s difficult to decide, whereas some say we don’t have sufficient choices. Today we are looking at the Old Testament story of Elijah and his battle with the people who were worshiping other gods or things; Baal, Asherah amongst many. Elijah has total trust in God and sets up a test in front of all the people he wanted to convince about their choice of not following God and relying on other things was not going to work. We think that ourselves too many times, we don’t rely on God in our lives. Elijah uses fire with a significant input from God! Fire is significant in the Old Testament but also in the New. What Elijah was trying to point out was ‘Who do you follow?’ Are you with God or not? A question we have to consider ourselves in our choices each day.
