I know I’ve spoken about this before Christmas and I’m talking about it again. How long have you waited for something significant to happen in your life? Sometimes it can be a long time and we may not even see it in our lifetime. Today we are looking at what really is the last bit of the Christmas narrative; ‘But that’s weeks ago we may say. The account of Simeon and Anna is a real-life lesson of waiting, waiting for God to fulfil His promises; Luke describes this as the ‘consolation of Israel’. The other thing that struck me was that the Holy Spirit was on him, real evidence that Pentecost wasn’t the first time He turned up! Simeon describes how ‘this child’s life will not be straightforward, that’s obvious to us! Simeon also describes Jesus’ life as the ‘Light to Lighten the Gentiles’, so He was for everyone. Are you still waiting for that Light? Jesus from His humble poor beginnings shows who He came for in His life and actions. Don’t wait to respond to ‘The Light of The World’.</p>
