However, there are also those things on our bucket list which we would love to do. Today we’re looking at one of the reluctant people in the Bible; Jonah. His story is so familiar, how he didn’t want to go to Nineveh and ended up in a whale, well a big fish so the Bible says. God often calls people, us to do things or go somewhere, sometimes places or situations we don’t fancy. Jonah’s story shows some consequences but it also shows something of God’s mercy. The people of Ninevah were not acting as God wanted, and Jonah eventually got there after God gave him a 2nd chance. We see that God will relent when ‘people turn from their evil ways’. God gives us 2nd chances if we are authentic in saying we’re sorry. His mercy is ‘everlasting’ we learn from His word, all we have to do is claim it.</p>
