I know I did, if we think about it that put our parents in an impossible situation; ‘I wonder what Dad or mum said we say so we’re consistent. If we want anything we are told to ask for it, otherwise how do people, or whoever know what we want? Today in our passage for the 2nd Sunday in Lent, Jesus tells us to ask, and He goes on to say that it will be given to us. Well, we may say He didn’t, but we need to remember that God knows the bigger picture and the answer to our prayers may well not be quite as we want them to be. In our passage Jesus states 3 prayer stages; Ask, seek, knock. Asking is the simplest prayer, seeking goes deeper which includes listening, knocking describes being persistence in our prayers. <i>SASB 783 Prayer gently lifts me to highest Heaven.</i> Jesus encourages us to be lifted to God in prayer. Let’s seek God in our prayers today.</p>
