Captain Andrew’s Column

‘Let’s Party!!’ We all love a party...don’t we? Today we are going to Party. This is a special day in the life of the Church, not just Ipswich but the whole world. It’s Pentecost, when we remember and celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit to a lot of people! Firstly it was the disciples, but it appears that there were many others there as well; women, Jesus’s mother Mary and his brothers plus loads of others who as we read, heard the Gospel in their own language. Fire is also a significant part of the story of Pentecost. The account in Acts says something like tongues of Fire was seen on the heads of the people present. If you have ever sat by a Fire, or if you’re old enough to have had one at home, you will know the comfort you get from a fire; it draws you in somehow. Fire also transforms things; it refines and purifies. ‘Refiners Fire’ is a song we sing about the transformational power of the Holy Spirit. SASB 326 ‘Send the Fire Today’ is the refrain from Wm Booths famous song. Let’s claim that fire today!
