**Major Jo’s Column**

Among other things The Salvation Army is a caring organization. Right from the beginning William Booth and others cared for the lowest of the low, he was well known for saying “go for souls and go for the worst”, in other words no one is beyond God’s reach and care.

While we all care about others there can be circumstances we would rather not deal with because we aren’t confident in getting it right. It is a horrible subject, but we have to be realistic, it can happen anywhere, and we must be prepared to give people the best possible help at the lowest times in their lives.

Mark 12:29-31

“The most important one,” answered Jesus, “is this: ‘Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: ‘Love your neighbour as yourself.’ There is no commandment greater than these.”
