‘Don’t give up!’ How many times have we heard that? Some of you will have done a marathon and I’m sure that’s what people were shouting from the side as you ran by; I know that’s what I heard when the Band were playing music at the recent Ipswich ½ Marathon; not to the Band but to the many participants running by!. Our Bible Reading is all about Not giving up. A woman pleading with a judge to get justice. There are many stories about people seeking justice; the Post Office scandal, the contaminated Blood issue, both have been in the news lately. These and others feature people who never gave up seeking justice, in the face of quite difficult barriers to getting it. Jesus uses a Parable or story to illustrate how we should never give up praying, speaking and listening to God; Matthew 7:7 and Song 744 say ‘Ask, seek, knock’ keep being persistence in prayer and as the song and Matthew says ‘knock and the door will open’. Is there something or someone you need to seek justice for, or speak to God about today? simply Ask and don’t give up!
