**Major Jo’s Column**

We all need it, we all want it and it can be a relief to receive it. What am I talking about? Forgiveness. “Forgive us our trespasses” is easy to say and mean but “as we forgive those who trespass against us” can be quite problematic. When we have been really hurt it is so much easier to tell all those who will listen about how badly we have been treated, highlighting all the other persons faults and holding on to a grudge. If we are able to stop ourselves behaving like this, it can still feel virtually impossible to forgive in the way the Bible teaches, especially if there is no sign of remorse from the one causing the hurt.

We usually think of forgiveness as something instant which ideally it should be but there are times when it is more of a process. In that situation it must start with the decision to follow Biblical teaching followed by asking the Holy Spirit to help you be willing to start the process of letting go. May God help each one of us we work on forgiving those who trespass against us.
