What kind of influence are we having on our children and the younger generations? Our young people are facing a much bigger variety of unhealthy lifestyles and choices than most of us did when we were growing up, they are expected to accept them as normal. Even more concerning is that some un-Biblical options are being accepted in many churches. If we want our children to grow up spiritually healthy, we must lead by example. What are our children learning from us? I'm not just talking to mothers here, we all have a responsibility. Do they see people willing to compromise Godly values for an easy life, or people of conviction and wisdom who are leading by example, willing to make sacrifices for what is right? In Titus 2:6-7 we read "Similarly, encourage the young men to be self-controlled. In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching, show integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech"</p>
