Major Jo’s Column

How easy is it for you to stick to Biblical principles and ways of living? As a general rule it isn’t much of a problem when surrounded by like-minded people but things can change quite quickly when in the company of people with different ideas of the best way to live.

Daniel chapter 1 sees him as a young man in a foreign country expected to conform to the expectations of those around him. Daniel remained strong and requested permission to keep to the healthy diet he was used to rather than the luxuries of the king’s table. After ten days of testing God’s way of looking after our bodies, was proved to be so much better that Daniel was granted his request and all the other young men alongside him were given the same simple food.

Daniel 1:8 “Then Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine, and he asked the chief official for permission not to defile himself in this way.”

May God give each of us the strength to follow Godly principles whatever company we are in.
