The writers of the letter to the Hebrews describes faith like this: “Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see (11:1).</p> <p>Therefore, what do we hope for? Are we confident we will receive what we hope for? Are we assured about what we hope for; that, which we as yet, cannot see?</p> <p>I will not ask how much faith we have, as we were reminded two weeks ago that ‘faith as small as a mustard seed can move mountains’. It is not about a great faith in God, rather faith in a great God.</p> <p>If we are confident we will receive what we hope for and assured of what we do not see, what happens to our faith when we do not receive or see it?</p>
