A day when we have a chance to pause and review where we are in our relationship with God. There are three elements we are thinking about this morning: Courageous Discipleship, Breaking Ground and Bringing Hope.</p> <p>It is not easy to be courageous disciples. Some of us were challenged this week about the possibility of joining various groups, so we could meet people and introduce them to church. It takes courage to accomplish that and do what God wants us to do.</p> <p>Sometimes we need to look at breaking the ground in our lives. We get settled into things like our own plans and dreams, our unhealthy habits and desires. We need to break those down. So often fear and insecurity can keep us from stepping out in faith or trusting God's goodness.</p> <p>Finally, we need to bring Hope. Living hope means embodying Christ's love in our everyday lives. It's a hope that doesn't stay within the church walls but reaches into our communities, bringing light and life wherever it goes!</p>
